### **10,000 Women to use New Career Advancement Tool in 2007**

**WASHINGTON, DC** — In 2007 more than 10,000 women across the country will use the Women Work! The free website and online job bank, launched in August, has seen a steady increase in the number of unique visitors during the last quarter of 2006.
